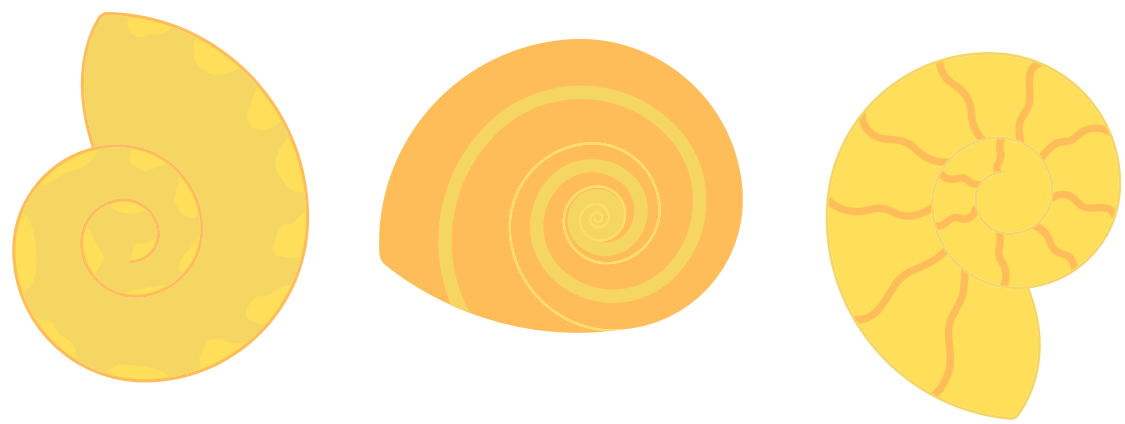
## How we're committed to keeping you safe

- We are cleaning Florida House on a daily basis, including **sanitizing all commonly-touched items**. We will be fully sanitizing the bathrooms.
- There will be **hand sanitizing stations** located on each level.
- We will be running **UV disinfecting technology** regularly, with a device proven 99.99% effective in removing harmful pathogens from the air and surfaces.
- The staff is **self-monitoring for signs of COVID-19**, and will not report to work if exhibiting symptoms.



## We're following all the guidelines from the CDC and the District of Columbia

- According to the District of Columbia, all guests and staff are **required to wear face masks** indoors, regardless of vaccination status.
- Remain **socially distanced** from others not in your household or party.

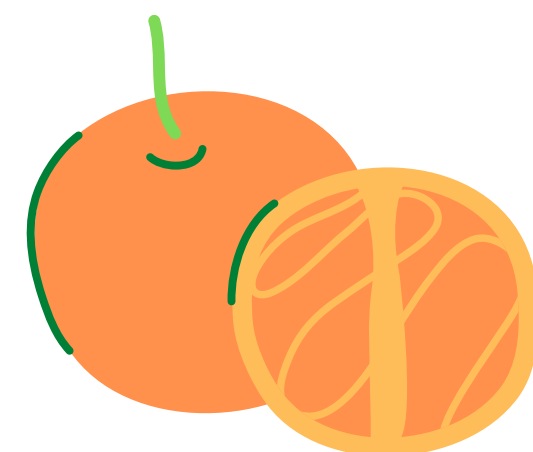


## Please Stay Home if...
